Meeting of Academic Council

25th August 2012

The Meeting of Academic Council of Ranchi Women's College, Ranchi held on 25th August 2012 in the Seminar Hall of Science Block at 11.30 am with three Members nominated by Ranchi University for two years, all the Heads and Coordinators of College and Principal as the Chairperson for discussion & resolution on following agenda:

- Academic Regulations for Courses, semester system examination, instructional and evaluation arrangements, methods, procedures there of from the academic session 2012-13
- > Approval of different syllabi for recommendation to Academic Council & Syndicate of Ranchi University
- Approval of New M Mus Course approved by Academic Council & Syndicate of Ranchi University
- > Approval of Seats for different Courses
- Recommendation to G.B. to institute 'Running Trophy' for the Topper of Economics sponsored by former H.o.D. Economics
- Regulations for Sports, Extra and Co Curricular Activities, proper maintenance and functioning of the playgrounds
- > Establishment of Research Centre
- > Any other academic matter (Appointment of Deans as per regulation)

As it was the first meeting of Ranchi Women's College Academic Council after achieving the status of autonomy so the Chairperson Dr. Manju Sinha welcomed all Heads and Coordinators of College as Members of Council and welcomed three Expert Members- two from Ranchi University Post Graduate Departments and third from Ranchi College, Ranchi - Dr S M P N Singh Shahi, Deptt. of English; Dr Ashok Kumar Choudhary, Deptt. of Botany & Dr Namita Singh, Deptt. of Physics as nominated Member of Academic Council by Ranchi University vide memo no. R.U./R/8124/12 dated 13.06.2012. She announced four names representing different areas as nominated Experts of Academic Council to be approved by the Management Board in its forthcoming committee to be held on 27th September 2012.

The agenda were discussed one by one and following resolutions were taken:

Academic Regulations: It was resolved that the regulations issued by Ranchi University for all autonomous colleges under Ranchi University will be followed in toto as per instruction of Ranchi University. The Course structure of Under Graduate level Honours/Major Subjects in six Semesters (each semester of six months - total course of three years), Post Graduate Course level Courses of four semesters (each semester of six months - total course of two years) running in the academic session from July to December and January to June (including admission and examination process) every year.

Evaluation of students' progress through two examinations in each semester - Mid Semester Exams. after 2nd month of Semester and End Semester Exams. after 5th month of Semester was approved. Thus students will have to appear in four examinations in a year now instead of one Annual Examination in a year. It was decided to follow the instructional and evaluation arrangements, methods, procedures as instructed by Ranchi University. However, the option for choice based credit system was also discussed for admission in some subjects as per consent of Deans of concerned subjects in Ranchi University. The Course structure and Examination Schedule was approved by the Council in the light of Ranchi iUniversity regulation. (Chart given in the end- Anx. 1 & Anx. 2).

Approval of Syllabi: As suggested in the regulation of UGC and RU Rules it was clear that all courses running in any constituent unit of University is deemed to be approved. But we need the approval of the syllabi being passed by the Board of Studies of Ranchio Women's College with certain modifications in course contents by some departments without distorting the format / structure of Semester wise teaching as approved by Ranchi University for autonomous Colleges under it. So all the courses were presented before the Experts. Some modifications / suggestions were made and all syllabi were approved by the Council for recommendation to the Academic Council and Syndicate of Ranchi University in Semester format.

Approval of new Course M. Mus.: The new Course of M Mus already approved by the Academic Council and Syndicate of Ranchi University was presented. But the Head of Music Department showed her inability in starting it right now due to some technical reasons like least (03) number of

applicants, problem of infrastructure - both Teachers, Room and Equipment etc. So it was decided to discuss this matter elaborately in another meeting.

Approval of Seats: The Chairperson suggested to fix the number of seats for admission in all subjects. With the consent of Heads of departments the sanctioned seats for admission in First Year was fixed. The number of seats for Vocational Courses was also fixed with consent of Coordinators and Chairperson. The Principal was given authority to enhance 5 to 10 % seats in Commerce, 5 & 2 seats respectively in each Subjects of Arts' & Science faculty and 5 to 10 seats in Self Financing Courses except B.Ed. if the pressure of applicants mounts heavily on the management. These will be additional seats beyond sanctioned seats.

- ➤ <u>Institution of Scholarship</u>, <u>Award</u>, '<u>Running Trophy' etc. for students</u>: As per UGC guidelines the Council discussed to institute Scholarship, Award, Trophy, Medal to students. It was unanimously resolved to sustain following running Trophies:
- (i) Running Trophy to the Topper Student of Final Year Economics Honours sponsored by former Head of Economics Department Mrs Meera Banerjee
- (ii) Individual Championship Trophy to the Best Athlete of Annual Athletic Meet of College.
- (iii) Running Overall Championship Trophy to the Winner Faculty in Annual Athletic Meet of College every year.
 - It was decided that the Principal be authorized to accept new proposals for instituting Medals, Awards, Trophies, Scholarships or any type of supportive scheme for Physically Challenged or BPL students for the welfare of students.
- Regulations for Sports, Extra and Co Curricular Activities: For this agenda Principal has been authorized to constitute new Committees for promotion and maintenance of sports, Extra and Co Curricular activities in the Campus delegating duties and power to these Sub Committees. The Principal informed the Council that she had sent a proposal to UGC Office for sanction of fund for wooden Badminton Court and mini stadium for the ground which has been accepted and UGC has released Rs. Twenty Three Lakhs to the College for this purpose in 2012. The Principal was authorized to look after the maintenance of three Hostels running in the College on "No Loss, No Profit" basis in the capacity of Warden with the help of Hostel Superintendents and Matrons for each Hostels.
- Establishment of Research Centre & Language Lab.: The proposal to request University to allow for establishing "Inter Disciplinary Research Centre" in the College for some subjects like Hindi, English, Political Science, Economics, History, Botany, Zoology and Chemistry was applauded and accepted unanimously. It will support Teaching Faculty to continue their research projects and get Research Scholars for M. Phil. & Ph. D. registered under them at this Centre. The Council approved the proposal of establishing Language Laboratory also.
- Appointment of Deans as Member of Academic Council: It was resolved to notify following four names out of senior teaching faculty members as Member of Academic Council in the capacity of Deans of four faculties. They will be in charge of all academic activities right from master routine publication to course completion, admission process, progress and evaluation of students, feedback on teaching by students, monitoring on teachers' research work, examination and evaluation up to tabulation and result publication of their respective faculties.

 - (ii) Dean, Commerce Faculty Dr. Neelima Herenze, Deptt. of Commerce
 - (iii) Dean, Humanities Faculty Dr. Kiran Mishra, Deptt. of English
 - (iv) Dean, Social Science Faculty Dr. Bina Tiru, Deptt. of History
 - The Chairperson of Academic Council nominated the name of Dr. Meena Sahay as over all-in-Charge (like wise Dean) of all Self Financing Courses in the College for smooth functioning, timely budget preparation, conduct of Practical Examinations and other important factors where her experienced suggestions can be sought.
