Initially, Ranchi Women's College was affiliated to the Patna University in **1951**. In **1957** the affiliation was shifted to the Bihar University which was carved out of Patna University as an independent unit. Finally, when Ranchi University emerged as an independent University in 1960, **Ranchi Women's College** was affiliated to it.

Ranchi Women's College is a government aided College which got recognition under **U.G. Act 1956 as 2(f) & 12B, 1956**. In **1987** it was transferred to the category of "**College Teaching up to Post Graduate Degree**" by UGC through letter no. F 8-105/86 (CPP-1) dated 3rd Nov. 1987 under section 2(f) UGC Act 1956

One of the most popular & oldest Colleges of Jharkhand , Ranchi Women's College is considered as a Premier Women's College of Jharkhand. It is situated in the heart of Ranchi, Capital of Jharkhand, at Circular Road with two separate Blocks-

1. Art's Block opposite Hari Om Tower
2. Science, Commerce & Vocational Block (Opp. Old Jail, Nagra Toli, Ranchi)

Ranchi Women's College has carved a niche for itself in the world of higher education for women in social sciences/ humanities, sciences and commerce. Emerging as a torch bearer in the field of Women Education Ranchi Women's college has grown to be a Centre of Excellence in the domain of higher education for women of Jharkhand, Bihar, West Bengal and Orissa. Another feather was added to its cap when this College got Autonomy Status by the UGC with effect from 2011-12.

Important Information for Admission Process

Girls seeking admission in the faculty of Arts (Fashion Designing & Computer Application), Science (Bio Technology, Clinical Nutrition & Dietetics, Computer Application and Information Technology) and Commerce (B.B.A. & Computer Application) must submit duly filled up separate Admission Form issued by the College at the college counter or by Speed Post (with DD of Rs. 550/- if internet version of Admission Form is downloaded from college website).

The photocopies of following documents must be submitted along with duly filled up Admission Form:

Original Documents Required at the time of Admission

1. The original certificates of above mentioned documents (as per requirement) should be produced at the time of admission.
2. Two more colour photos are required for official use
3. Original Migration Certificate will be taken by the College at the time of admission
4. All students will have to purchase syllabus at the time of admission

Rules & Regulations For Students

Admitted students will have to strictly follow the rules & regulations laid down by the College. Violation of rules or instructions will be recorded in the Identity Card and College Record as warning. After third recorded violation the College reserves the right to terminate/expel the student from College at a nystage. Following Rules should be remembered and followed:

1. **UNIFORM:** Students should come to the College in College Uniform only. Dress Code (College Uniform) is mandatory. Rs. 50/- will be fined if found without uniform.
2. **MOBILE:** Use of Cell Phone / Mobile inside the College Building is not allowed. If any student is found using mobile phones inside the Class Room, Corridor or office of the College, her phone will be seized followed by fine of Rs. 50/-.
If any students will argue with Teacher or Staff, other disciplinary action will be taken against her which may lead to expulsion.
3. **ATTENDANCE :** All students will have to attend minimum 75 % Theory Classes & 90 % of Practical classes in all Semesters. **Students below 75 % attendance in Theory & 90 % in Practical will not be allowed** to fill up the Examination Form or appear for the End Sem. Examination.
4. **LEAVE IN EMERGENCY :** If the student is unable to attend the classes for more than five days due to her illness, marriage, illness in family, any crucial problem in family, participation in Sports competitions outside the state or any other reason then she can write / send an application to the Principal / Coordinator / Teacher either direct or through registered Post or by any person for condoning short attendance on basis of sufficient proof. In such cases only



her shortage of attendance can be made up by **extra classes** otherwise she will not be allowed to fill up the Examination Form.

5. **IDENTITY CARD & PROSPECTUS:** Every Student will have to carry her Identity Card and Prospectus (Specially rules and regulation's pages) when she is in the College. She will not be given entry in the College without her Identity Card. If she is found without Identity Card & Prospectus she will be fined with Rs.25/-.
6. **TWO WHEELER:** If any student comes by Two-Wheeler, she will have to submit the copy of her Date of Birth, Driving License and an undertaking that she will always use Helmet; She will never ride without Helmet; She will never ride with more than one person at a pillion.
7. **NOTICE BOARD :** Every student will have to develop the habit of reading the latest notice on College Notice Board every time she enters the College and leaves the College.
8. **ORNAMENT / JEWELLERY :** No student is permitted to put on ornaments or jewellery except during college function. No student should carry heavy amount in college unless fee deposit time.
9. **LOITER AROUND :** Students should not loiter around Principal's Chamber / Building Corridors/in front of classrooms without any reason.
10. **SITTING ON VEHICLES :** Students should not sit on any vehicle parked in the Campus. No one should use any parked vehicle as table to write anything. If found guilty the student will be fined Rs.50/-.
11. **MALE MEMBER:** These days it is found that students invite male members of the family or male friend to the college campus. If any student invites any outsider male member inside the college campus she will be fined Rs. 100/-.
12. **SHOPPING DURING COLLEGE HOURS:** Students are warned not to bunk Classes and move around near by shops or malls during College Hours. If anyone is found doing so she will be taken to task.
13. **REGISTRATION FOR COLLEGE LIBRARY :** Students are directed to get their names registered in the college library within one month after admission. A student can borrow two books from the library at a time for twelve days after due record in the Identity Card. . But if the books are not returned by the due date a fine of 50 Paise per day will be charged for each book. No student is allowed to enter the library without her Identity Card. The personal belongings brought inside the library will be seized. Students can avail the facility of reprography (Xerox) on payment of Rs.1/- per page in the library itself. Poor Students will be issued two books @ 5/- only for three months continuously from the departmental Book Bank. Students can read magazines, books and papers in the Reading Room of the library during prescribed hours notified on the Notice Board of the library. In case of loss of books the student will have to submit the same book of the same edition or latest edition in the library at the due time of returning the book. If the student does not return the book or fails to submit the lost book on time, she will have to pay the cost of that book thrice the price as per Ranchi University rule. If any student wishes any special newspaper or magazine or relevant book as per courses she can give her requisition to the Coordinator or Librarian in writing.
14. **USE OF WiFi:** The College students can avail the facility of WiFi campus free of cost only if they get themselves registered at College Server for which they have to contact System Administrator.
15. **GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL :** For redressal of different types of grievances students can mail to ranchi.womens.college@gmail.com or can send SMS to 9431382483. The Grievance Redressal Cell will urgently take up the matter to redress the grievance.



17. BAN ON RAGGING : Ragging is banned in the College. This College is reputed for excellent teaching and strict discipline. It has formed an "Anti Ragging Committee" and "Anti Ragging Squad" as per the guidelines of UGC which take up the cases and solve problems if any. There is one Proctor Board that looks after proper maintenance of discipline and leaves no scope for ragging and unruly conduct. Anybody found involved in any kind of misbehavior leading to ragging will be expelled from the college after the decision of the Proctor Board. Besides, FIR will be lodged against those students who will be found exercising ragging and bullying on the campus or around the campus. Several flex boards displaying about ragging and punishment against ragging have been installed in all buildings, Hostels and entry gate for proper knowledge.

What is Ragging?

Any disorderly conduct either by words (spoken or written) or by any act which has the effect of teasing, ill treating or handling with rudeness, causing harm, fear or apprehension or asking any student to perform any such act which may put a fresher to shame or embarrassment or adversely affect the physique or psyche of the fresher is considered as ragging.

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Proctorial Board of the college, the possible punishment for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

Punishment at the Institution level for Ragging

- (i) Cancellation of admission
- (ii) Suspension from attending classes
- (iii) Withholding/Withdrawal of scholarship/fellowship & other benefits.
- (iv) Debarring from appearing in any test examination or being evaluated
- (v) Withholding results.
- (vi) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- (vii) Rustication from the institution for a certain period.
- (ix) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from the admission to any other institution.
- (x) Fine of Rs. 25,000/- to Rs. 1 Lakh.
- (xi) Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

So all students are strictly warned against ragging. Ragging is, now, a crime. No one can feign ignorance of the law. In pursuance of the directions/decisions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, those who indulge in ragging can be punished with:

- (a) Jail for period ranging from Six months to Ten years.
- (b) Fine up to Rs. 50,000/-
- (c) Embossing of certificate that "The student had indulged in ragging" which will:
 - Adversely affect career prospects.
 - Adversely affect opportunities to go abroad for the student on whose certificate it would be embossed that he/she had indulged in ragging as a result they will not get passport and Visa.

All students and their Parents will have to undertake the following oath against ragging at the time of admission by filling the form against ragging.

DETAILS OF SELF FINANCING COURSES

1. Bio-Technology

Bio-Technology is a job and research oriented three years' Honours Course at Under GraduatedegreelevelrunningundervocationalProgrammesapprovedbyU.G.C.since1996.Thecoursecurriculum is designed with an aim to impart knowledge about recent developments in variousbiologicalfieldssuchasGeneticengineering,PlantTissueCulture,Immunology,Microbiologyetc.

Job opportunities and Advance Studies

The main emphasis of this Vocational Course is not only to award B.Sc. (Hons) degree but also to prepare the students for basics in research, entrepreneurship development and to get jobs in pharma industries as well as Bioinformatics (IT) companies.

Employment opportunities exist in research, production and marketing in the areas of medicine and healthcare, agriculture, animal husbandry, environment and industry etc. The work of biotechnologists is essentially scientific and research-oriented. Main areas of work are production of various bio processed materials, marketing of biotechnology products and processes in various areas, research and bioinformatics application of information technology to the management of biological information etc.

Study of Bio Technology caters to the industrial sectors such as food and beverages industry, textiles industry, biological products, medicines and pharmaceuticals while on the other hand this branch of science caters to the requirements of agriculture, animal husbandry, nutrition and environmental conservation. It is not confined or bound as a single discipline. Rather it is an interdisciplinary branch of science that is rapidly gaining significance and opportunities for youngsters who want to explore the new frontiers of science. Apart from biology, this branch of science also assimilates diverse subjects like physics, chemistry, mathematics and computer. Furthermore, engineering applications are also an integral constituent of biotechnology.

Eligibility

A girl student passing I.Sc./10+2 (Science with Biology) with Minimum 45% marks in aggregate will be eligible for admission in First Year of Bio Technology in Ranchi Women's College provided. Eligible candidates can take direct admission on the 'first come first serve basis' till the availability of the seats.

Age Limit: The applicant must be of seventeen years or before 1st October 2014.

5. Fashion Designing

"Fashion Designing" is a form of art dedicated to the creation of clothing and other lifestyle accessories. Fashion design is influenced by cultural and social attitudes. To work as a designer, one should have an artistic and creative personality. The student also has to be good at drawing and able to express her ideas in sketches. She doesn't necessarily have to be a great artist, but she must have some special skills for combining colors, tones and shades. She also has to be able to work with fabric and use textiles in a creative and original manner. Fashion designers have a good visual imagination and are able to think in three-dimensions and put their ideas into garments. Fashion designers have to be aware of the fashion market requirements. They have to be very interested in learning new things and read magazines, journals and books on fashion design history and new trends. They also have to be interested in art, visit art galleries and interact with all kinds of artists whenever they have the opportunity. A designer should also have some knowledge and experience of tailoring (cutting, draping, sewing etc.) and be able to tell the difference between different fabric quality levels. A good understanding of the audience's lifestyle and customer needs and requirements is also needed in fashion design. Designers should have good communication skills and be able to express their ideas clearly. But most important, they have to be very original and have fresh, innovative ideas. There are a number of well known specialized arts schools and design schools worldwide that offer degrees in fashion design and fashion design technology. Ranchi Women's College has the credit to offer it first of all in Jharkhand State as a self-financing (Job Oriented) Honours Course of three years at UG level.

Job Opportunities and Career Prospects:

Fashion Designing is concerned with designing apparels and accessories for men, women and children. Other than clothes, fashion designing includes designing of jewellery, footwear, bags and other accessories. The designer has to take care of size, fitting, style, colour, texture and material. Fashion Designing can be categorized into: (1) Textile or fabrics Designing, (2) Leather Designing (including garments, foot wear and accessories), (3) Jewellery Designing. Some Fashion designers work as freelance designers and design for individual clients or sell to stores or cloth manufactures. Some designers work for fashion company and design for the company only. Other designers start their own fashion shops or stores and sell under their own label. One can find job with Export houses, textile mills, boutiques, garment stores, leather companies, jewellery houses after completing degree course in fashion designing.
