

- 8. **ORNAMENT** / **JEWELLERY** : No student is permitted to put on ornaments or jewellery exceptduringcollege function. Nostudent should carry heavyamount in college unless fee deposittime.

- 11. **MALEMEMBER:** These days it is found that students invite male members of the family or male friends to the ecollege campus. If any student invites any outsider male member inside the college campus she will be fined Rs. 100/-.
- 12. **SHOPPINGDURINGCOLLEGEHOURS**: StudentsarewarnednottobunkClasses and move around nearbyshopsormalls during College Hours. If anyone is found doing so she will be taken to task.
- 13. **REGISTRATION FOR COLLEGE LIBRARY**: Students are directed to get their names registeredin the college library within one month after admission. A student can borrowtwo books from the library at a time for twelve days after due record in the Identity Card. . But ifthebooks are not returned by the due date a fine of 50 Paise per day will be charged for each book. No student is allowed to enter the library withoutherIdentity Card. The personalbelongingsbroughtinsidethelibrarywillbeseized. Studentscanavailthefacilityofreprography (Xerox) on payment of Rs. 1/-per page in the library itself. Poor Students will be issued two books @ 5/- only for three months continuously from the departmental Bank. Studentscanreadmagazines, books and papers in the Reading Room of the library during prescribed hours notified on the Notice Board of the library. In case of loss of books the student will havetosubmitthesamebookofthesameeditionorlatesteditioninthelibraryattheduetimeofreturning book. If the student does not return the book or fails to submit the lost book ontime, she will have to pay the cost of that book thrice the price as per Ranchi University rule. 17. BAN ON RAGGING: Ragging is banned in the College. This College is reputed for excellentteaching and strict discipline. Ithasformedan"AntiRaggingCommittee"and"AntiRaggingSquad"asperthe guidelinesofUGC whichtakeupthecases and solves problems if any. There is one Proctor Board that looks after proper maintenance of disciplineand leaves no scope for ragging and unruly conduct. Anybody found involved kindofmisbehaviorleadingtoraggingwillbeexpelledfromthecollegeafterthedecisionofthe Proctor Board. Besides, FIR will be lodged against those students who will be found exercising ragging and bullying the campus around campus. Severalflex on or the boarddisplayingaboutraggingandpunishment against ragginghave beeninstalled in all buildings, Hostelsandentrygateforproperknowledge.

WhatisRagging?

Anydisorderlyconducteitherbywords(spokenorwritten)orbyanyactwhichhastheeffectofteasing,illtreating orhandlingwithrudeness,causingharm,fearorapprehensionoraskinganystudent to perform any such act which may put a fresher to shame or embarrassment or adverselyaffectthephysiqueorpsycheofthefresherisconsideredasragging.

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Proctorial Board of the college, the possible punishment for those found guilty of ragging at the institution levels hall be any one or any combination of the following:

Punishment at the Institution level for Ragging

- (i) Cancellation of admission
- (ii) Suspensionfromattending classes
- (iii) Withholding/Withdrawingscholarship/fellowship&otherbenefits.
- (iv) Debarringfromappearinginanytestexaminationorbeingevaluated
- (v) Withholdingresults.
- (vi) Debarringfromrepresentingtheinstitutioninanyregional,nationalorinternationalmeet,tournament,yo uthfestivaletc.
- (vii) Rustication from the institution for acertain period.
- (ix) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from the admission to any other institution.
- (x) FineofRs.25,000/-toRs.1Lakh.
- (Xi) Collectivepunishment: Whenthepersons committing or a betting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

 - Adverselyaffectopportunitiestogoabroadforthestudentsonwhosecertificatesitwould embossedthathe/shehadindulgedintoraggingasaresulttheywillnotgetpassportandVisa.




