Madam,

With reference to your letter no. G/166/A/13 dated 17.10.2013 A on the subject noted above, I am directed to inform you that the matter was placed before the meeting of the Ranchi University Academic Council on 29.04.2014 for consideration and the Academic Council after due consideration took the following decision vide resolution no. 04/14 dated 29.04.2014:

विचारोपरान्त संकल्प लिया गया कि रॉची मिहला महाविद्यालय, रॉची में स्नातक स्तर के कम संख्या 1 से 21, कम सं0 23 से 24 एवं कम सं0 26 से 28 तक दर्शाये गये विषयों एवं उनके सामने अंकित सीटों की संख्या एवं संबंधित पाठ्यकम (Syllabus) तथा स्नातकोत्तर स्तर के कम संख्या 1 से 10 तक दर्शाये गये विषयों एवं उनके सामने अंकित सीटों की संख्या एवं संबंधित पाठ्यकम (Syllabus) के संबंध में महाविद्यालय के विद्वत परिषद् के संकल्प संख्या 2 में लिये गये निर्णयों को स्वीकृत किया जाय।

पुनः संकल्प लिया गया कि कम संख्या 22 में Bio-Technology विषय के सामने अंकित 85 सीट के स्थान पर 65 सीट ही स्वीकृत किया जाय।

पुनः संकल्प लिया गया कि कम संख्या 25 में Bisuness Administration विषय के सामने अंकित 120 सीट के साथ इस शर्त के साथ स्वीकृत किया जाय कि महाविद्यालय इस विषय को 60 विद्यार्थियों के दो वर्ग में BBA की पढ़ाई संचालित करेगा।

रॉची महिला महाविद्यालय के विद्वत परिषद् के संकल्प संख्या 4 में लिये गये निम्नांकित निर्णय

"It was reported by the Head of Philosophy and Sanskrit Departments that a number of IA or Plus Two passed students come to apply for Philosophy and Sanskrit Honours even though they had not opted these subjects at Plus Two level. As per Ranchi University rule the student should have obtained at least 45% marks in subject concerned at the Intermediate or equivalent examination. (Rules for admission in UG & PG courses vide memo no. P/4198-4272 dated 26/09/94). In the light of plenty of vacant seats in these subjects the Council recommends this matter to the Ranchi University to allow any student who has passed IA or equivalent examination in Arts Faculty with subjects of Social Science or Humanities without Philosophy or Sanskrit to take admission in Philosophy or Sanskrit Honours (both under Humanities) in the same manner as students of Science (I.Sc. passed) can take admission in B.Com. or B.A. Honours and students of Commerce (I.Com. passed) can take admission in any subject of BA Honours provided they have obtained 45% aggregate.





- 4. Non Posting of marks of two examinees of PG Internal Semester Two by the Teachers of English & Economics Department respectively. Supplementary submission after publication of result: The Board was reported that the Head of two departments (English & Economics) could not post the marks of PG Internal Semester Two of one student each department at the time of submitting Marks Foil to the Examination Department. After publication of result these students were shown absent. They brought this matter to the light that they appeared in the said Examination. Then the Heads submitted supplementary Marks Foil to the Examination Department. The Board decides to send "Letter of Condemn" to concerned Heads for this blunder that can harm the academic career of students. And it was decided to revise the result of these students.

Resolution:

1. Construction of ATM Room in Science Block Campus for Oriental Bank of Commerce:

Ranchi University has approved the proposal for construction/installation of ATM in the college and conveyed it vide memo no.PL/1485 dated 29/10 2013. The estimated cost of Rs.1,88,080/- was approved for this construction. The Committee decides that instead of taking loan from the bank the college will provide Rs.1,88,080/- to the Oriental Bank of Commerce, Ranchi Women's College, Ranchi Branch for this construction as per plan and estimate approved earlier because college will have to pay a heavy amount as interest if it takes loan from the bank. The Bursar of college has reported that currently the college has Rs.11,84,178/- in "A/c C" under the head of Building & Development Fund. (Note sheet & other documents attached)

2. Purchase & installation of new collapsible gate in the building of Science Block, of College: It has been reported that the collapsible gate of Science block building (fitted in 1976) is completely damaged and it can not be repaired. The purchase and installation of new collapsible gate is very urgent in light of security point of view for girl students studying here. So it is decided to get it installed as soon as possible. The Committee decides to complete this work at departmental level for which Rs. 10,000/- will be advanced to Prof-in-Charge Dr. Meena Sahay. (photo of damaged collapsible gate attached)

- 3. Renovation/repair of Roof Shed at Vocational Building Science Block of College:
 - It has been reported by the Controller of the Examinations that some portion of shed made of aluminum sheets at roof of Vocational Building got damaged after incessant heavy rain during last week. The pouring water is damaging all electrical wires of computers, printers of examination cell. So the committee decides to renovate/repair the roof shade at departmental level to protect the electrical equipments on war footing. The committee decides to advance Rs.10,000/- to the Controller of Examinations, Prof. Subhra Chatterjee to get the renovation/repair fast.
- 4. Construction of wooden Computer Tables for BBA & Mathematics Laboratory :

The demand of BBA Coordinator and Head of Mathematics department was considered for supply of computer tables for their Computer Laboratories. It was reported that readymade computer tables purchased earlier for this lab are being destroyed very soon so the Committee decides to complete the Computer Laboratory (construction of more Computer Tables for 32 students) at departmental level. The estimated cost for these Computer table was taken from a local carpenter. This estimate is of Rs.75,600/- with labour cost and materials which is cheaper than market rate of computer tables. The committee decides to get this work complete at departmental level for which the coordinator, BBA Dr Lily Mary Kujur will be advanced the cost of expenditure in two installments from the fund of BBA. (Estimate & map attached)

- 5. Construction of shade for students in front of Counters of Examination Cell:
 - The Controller of Examinations has complained that there is no shed for students and they suffer from torrent rain showers in rainy and scorching sun in peak summer season due to which they fall ill. For construction of 30'x10' in size shed for examination counters the management verbally negotiated with Mrs Suchitra Agrawal, proprietor of Speed'O'print (printer & supplier of admission prospectus and forms) for supporting college. The proprietor Mrs. Suchitra Agrawal has agreed to construct half portion of the shed. The committee agrees that the half cost of shed will be borne by the college and half by the Speed'O'Print. The estimated cost comes to approximately Rs.50,000/-. The committee decides to get the exact estimated cost and bear the half of the portion (Copy attached) The cost of this construction will be paid from Building and Development fund of the College in "A/c C. as mentioned at agendum no. 1.
- 6. Construction of back gate in Arts Block near auditorium & boundary wall of UGC Hostel:

 It has been reported by the Acting Head Assistant of the college that main gate at the rear side of the college has been totally damaged so it has been locked and blocked from some months for no entry. This is causing lots of inconvenience to the students, staff & teachers. Moreover we always remain scared because unsocial elements try to intrude into the campus through this almost worn out gate. Similarly the boarders of UGC Hostel have demanded for boundary wall for safety point of view. The committee decides to get the estimate from the University Engineer for both construction after which the Principal is authorized to get both work completed at departmental level. The payment will be made from fund in "A/c C" and Hostel maintenance fund respectively.
- 7. Purchase and installation of Aqua Guard for students at five places:

 For installation of Aqua Guard (as per strong instruction of Voce Chancellor, Ranchi University) the Principal reported that she has sent a letter to the CCDC, RU for the approved rate passed by university purchase committee with name m model, capacity of Aqua Guard. The Committee decides to purchase the same Aqua Guard at same rate for college. The copy of rate will be provided by CCDC, RU.
- 8. Post approval to LAN wiring in CA & IT department and Art's Block Library

The committee grants post approval to the wiring work completed in CA & IT department and Art's Block Library for internet surfing & maintenance of automation of office, admission and library through server.



NATIONAL UNIVERSITY STUDENTS' SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (NUSSD)





Background Note

The National University Student Skill Development (NUSSD) is a Pilot Programme undertaken in 9 States across 11 Universities mostly in backward rural districts, particularly in Central India, starting in 2013; and aims at increasing employability of National Service Scheme (NSS) students by imparting knowledge and skills, through cutting edge pedagogy and learning materials, while undertaking community work that brings about sustainable social change.

The Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports has been in consultation with office of Advisor to Prime Minister on Skill Development (APM office) on 'National University Student Skill Development Programme (NUSSD); to introduce "Skill Training" so that the graduating youth acquire job related skills through immersive projects. This programme involves college student engagement over three years in a multi stakeholder collaborative model involving NGO's, Universities and Corporate.

Tata Institute of Social Sciences is the key knowledge partner. As proof of concept, the Ministry of Youth Affairs (YAS) has agreed to conduct a Pilot by partnering with APM office and TISS.

Purpose

- 1. Foster socially conscientious students grounded in respect for people and concerned about the welfare of others.
- 2. Develop skills, competencies and knowledge to intervene in an equal and sustainable manner in the social and economic development of people.
- 3. Gain a Diploma in specific competencies and skills enhancing employability in addition to receiving a Degree in the field of study.

NUSSD Courses

A basic proficiency in six courses has been identified as foundational for all 60,000 students. This would be completed in the first year of graduation and would lead to the award of a Certificate in Management and Soft Skills. The certificate would be given lay the School of Vocational Education, Tata Institute of Social Sciences.

Foundational Courses

The six foundational courses are:

- · Motivating Youth for Skill Building
- Digital Literacy
- Financial literacy
- Legal literacy
- · English and Communication
- Youth Leadership & Soft Skills
- Working with Communities leading to a field practicum

After the completion of foundational courses there would be other vocational courses. Students successfully completing all course requirements will be awarded the appropriate level of certification by the School of Vocational Education, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai.

About 'Motivating Youth for Skill Building'

The 'Motivating Youth for Skill Building' is a fifteen-hour non-graded activity. These sessions are taken with the students either prior to the introduction of the Foundational courses or alongside them. The motivation and skill building workshops will introduce the participants to the overall goals of the NUSSD programme, encourage group building and cohesion among them as well as provide opportunities for basic skill building in communication, self awareness and interpersonal relationships. These sessions will be conducted in a participatory method through simulated exercises; small inputs sessions, group discussion, and 'beyond the classroom' exercises. The sessions are designed towards increasing self confidence, ability to communicate and participate well within groups and are an introduction to building soft skills.

Please Note: These sessions are only an initiation into soft skills building. Within the Foundational courses there is a graded substantive course on "Youth Leadership and Soft Skills' that is introduced later in the programme.

The session facilitators are primarily college/University faculty members who have volunteered their time and efforts for this endeavour. The TISS faculty coordinators and programme officers will coordinate/liaison with the facilitators and the respective colleges where the NUSSD programme has been initiated. Support will be provided in areas of the academic component, administrative and logistics requirements.

Broad Session Themes are:

- Group building
- > Exploring 'motivation'
- Communication
- > Relationship building
- Goal Setting

Each of the above themes is explored through a variety of exercises and discussion. There could be either one session of three hours or over two sessions with each session comprising one and half hours. If two sessions are conducted the facilitator will have to conclude each session, summarizing the key points arising out of the session.



इस कार्यक्रम का **उद्घाटन** राँची विश्वविद्यालय के राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना संयोजक डा० प्रकाश कुमार झा एवम प्राचार्या डा० मंजु सिन्हा ने अपने आँखों की जाँच करवा कर किया. उसके बाद छात्राओं, स्टाफ एवम शिक्षिकाओं के द्वारा जाँच कराने का तांता लगा रहा. कुल चार सौ अट्ठाईस लोगों के नेत्र की जाँच हुई.

इस जाँच शिविर से चौंकाने वाले तथ्य सामने आये. लगभग दश प्रतिशत छात्राओं की ही दृष्टि सामान्य पाई गयी . दश प्रतिशत छात्राओं की दायों आँख की रोशनी धुँधली निकली. अस्सी प्रतिशत छात्रायें "मायोपिया" से प्रसित पायी गयीं जिसका ज्ञान उन्हें पहले नहीं था. कहते हैं कि मायोपिया के शिकार वे छात्र—छात्रायें होते हैं जिनका आई क्यू ज्यादा होता है और जो ज्यादा पढ़ने वाले होते हैं. कुछ लोगों में यह अनुवांशिक भी होता है. वासन आई केयर हौस्पीटल प्रबंधन ने ऐसी सभी छात्राओं के मुफ्त इलाज का बीड़ा उठाया है .

इस कार्यक्रम को सफल बनाने में कार्यक्रम पदाधिकारी डा० नम्रता सिन्हा, डा० प्रज्ञा गुप्ता, डा० गीता एवम एन एस एस वोल्न्टियर्स का काफी योगदान रहा.

जो सर्वे उन्होंने किया उसका आंकड़ा आज बनाया जिसके मुताबिक उन ३६० घरों में कुल ७१३ पुरूष हैं. उनमें से ५२३ शिक्षित हैं और १६० अशिक्षित. महिलाओं की कुल संख्या ७१८ है जिनमें से मात्र ३२८ शिक्षित हैं और ३६० अशिक्षित. स्त्री—पुरूष के लिंगानुपात से जहाँ सुखद अनुभव हुआ वहीं स्त्री शिक्षा में दर्ज गिरावट से दुख हुआ. कुल ४२७ बच्चों में से ४०० पढ़ने जाते हैं और २७ बच्चे लाचारी में शिक्षा को लालायित हो कर बस बेबसी की नजरों से देख रहे थे. ४२६ बच्चियों में से ३७७ शिक्षा का लाभ उठा रही हैं पर ४६ अभी भी वंचित हैं.

पढ़ाई प्रारंभ करने के बाद छोड़ने वाले ६ से १६ वर्ष की आयु सीमा के बीच के बच्चों का भी इन्होंने सर्वे किया जिससे यह आंकड़ा सामने आया कि कुल १०१ लड़कों ने जहाँ पढ़ाई बीच में ही छोड़ दी वहीं मात्र ५१ लड़कियाँ ही ड्रौप आउट की शिकार मिलीं.

इस बार छात्राओं का विशेष आग्रह यह जानने पर भी रहा कि गरीबी की मार झेल रहे इस झोपड्पट्टी के बाशिन्दों में से कितने खुशनसीब ऐसे हैं जिन्हें "निर्धनता रेखा" से नीचे रहने वाले लोगों को प्राप्य सुविधाओं को पाने का अधिकार सरकार ने "बी.पी.एल. कार्ड" दे कर नवाजा है. इनके द्वारा सर्वें में शामिल कुल ३६० परिवार में से अभी तक गरीबी में गुजर—बसर करते कुल २२५ परिवार ऐसे मिले जिन्हें आज तक बी.पी.एल. कार्ड मयस्सर नहीं हुआ. जिन किसी को मिला भी है उन्हें भी समय पर पर्याप्त राशन नहीं मिलता. क्यों ? इसका जवाब सरकार के चुने नुमाइन्दों को तो देना ही चाहिये!

कुल मिला कर इन छात्राओं ने सात दिनों के भीतर चुनिन्दा इश्युज पर जन—जागरण की एक मुहिम तैयार की और सफलता भी पाई. जैसे कि

- ७. और अंतिम दिन निर्धन परिवारों में अपनी तरफ से वस्त्र और गर्म कपड़े वितरण कर अपनेपन और समरस कुटुम्ब का भाव जगाना
- छात्राओं ने खुद से नालियाँ सफाई करके प्रदर्शित किया, बर्तन स्वच्छता से साफ करना सिखलाया, बच्चों को वर्णमाला सिखा कर पढ़ने के प्रति आकर्षित किया और स्वस्थ रहना सजग रहना सिखलाय!


