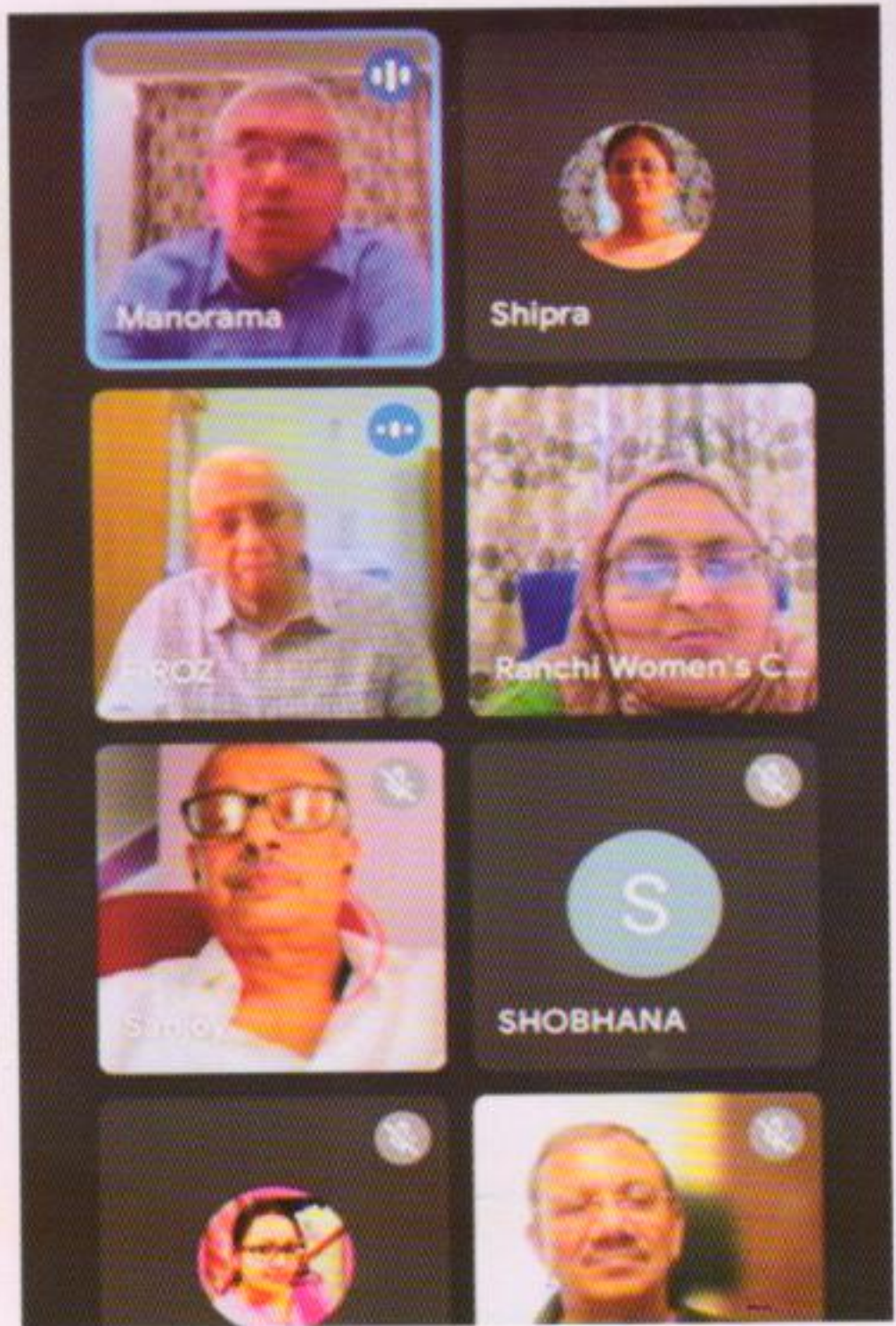


Academic Activities

During the year 2021, Offline classes could be conducted for a very short period of time due to the Covid-19 pandemic. However, all possible steps were taken by the college management to minimize the problems faced by students through Online mode of teaching learning process. Faculty members took special care to tackle the challenges of the widening digital divide. The required Offline examinations were conducted following the prescribed Covid protocol and the results were declared on time.

The raging pandemic necessitated an online organization of the regular annual Academic Council Meeting on the 29th June, 2021. The meeting, chaired by the principal, Dr. Shamsun Nehar, was held in the presence of eminent educationists as University Nominees. The meeting was attended by the expert nominees from different fields of society as education, Industry, Health and all the Deans, Departmental Heads and Coordinators of Ranchi Women's College.

The Member Secretary, Academic Council, Dr. Shipra Kumari, presented the Implementation Report of the proposals made in the previous AC meeting and conducted the meeting. As per the proposed National Education Policy, 2020, the focus remained on the skill development of students for better employability. Some of the major decisions after minutes confirmation of the last Academic Council meeting are as follows:



Online Academic Council Meeting on 29.6.2021

- Approval granted to the changes in the curriculum proposed by the Board of Studies of different departments after due discussions and some valuable suggestions.
- A "Centre for Languages" to be established which shall run different Self-financed Short-duration Language Courses including Translation from the next Academic Session.
- Skill based short-duration courses to be run under different departments with a focus on self-employability.
- Department of Fashion Designing to be developed into a Centre of Excellence.
- Approval to proposal to start two PG courses in Psychology and Sanskrit.
- Proposal to award a gold medal to the student securing highest marks in Commerce stream. It is to be instituted in memory of late Sri Prem Kumar Poddar by Sri Punit Poddar.

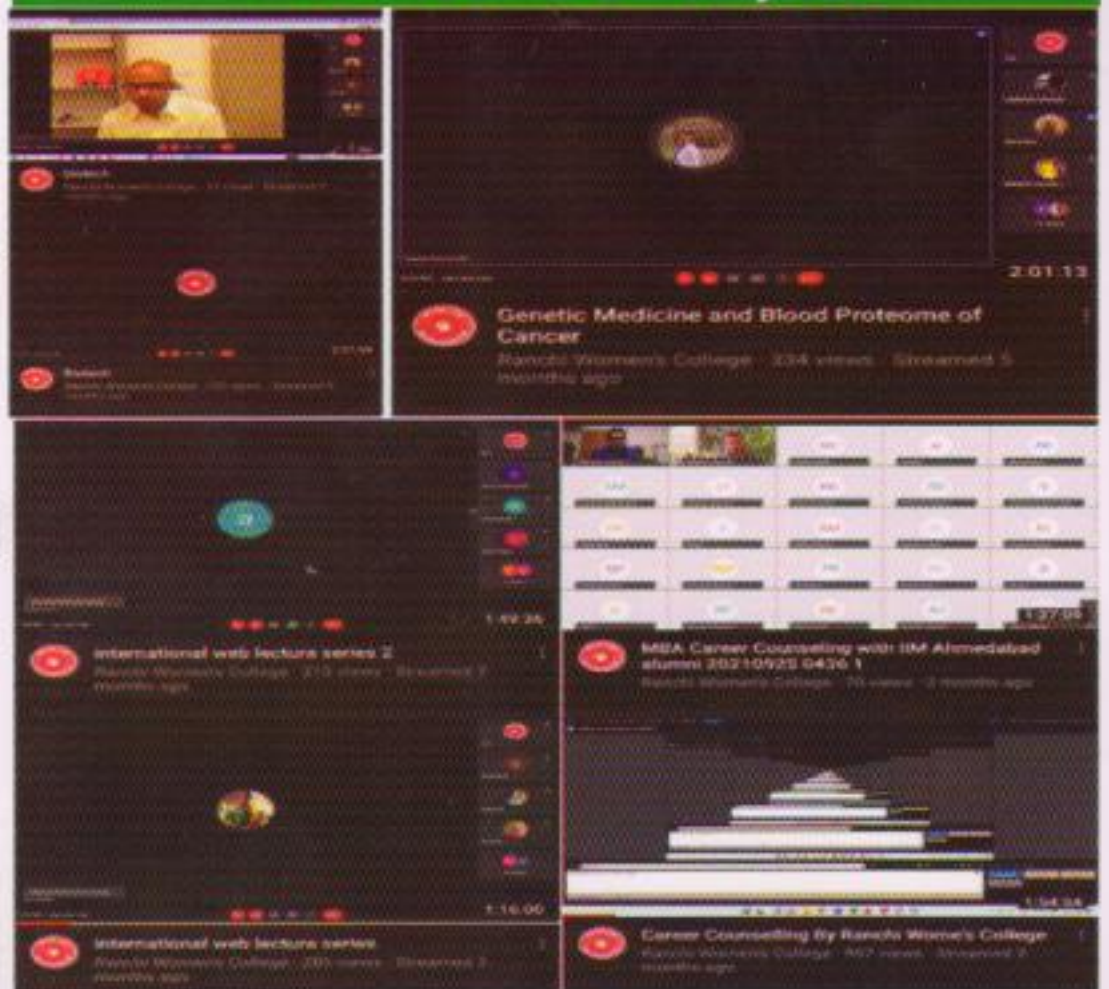

The Placement Cell of our college has taken the initiative to approach those organisations, institutions and individuals who have the acumen to appreciate this problem with ease and are engaged in employability and skill development training pertaining to different fields of study.

Glimpses of various training programs undertaken by Ranchi Women's College in the year 2021:

CERTIFICATE PROGRAMME IN BANKING, FINANCE AND INSURANCE-CPBFI

CPBFI is a customized training programme conducted by Bajaj Finserv for graduates, especially the first-generation graduates, across India. CPBFI aims to make these graduates employable for the Banking, Financial Services and Insurance (BFSI) sector. 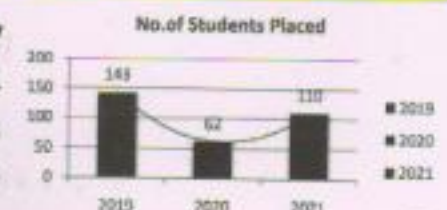

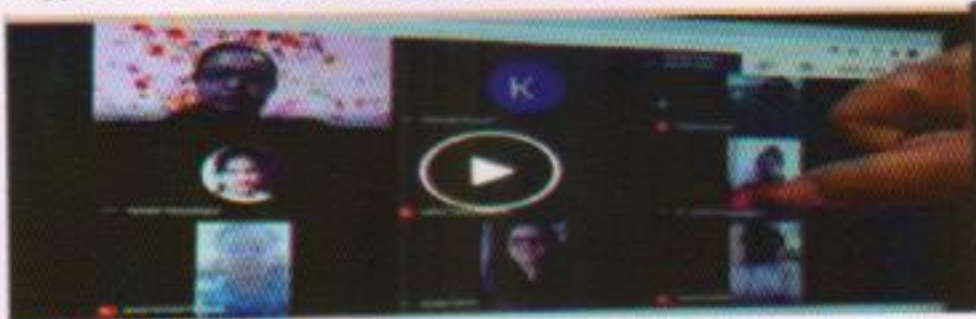
24.1.2021:

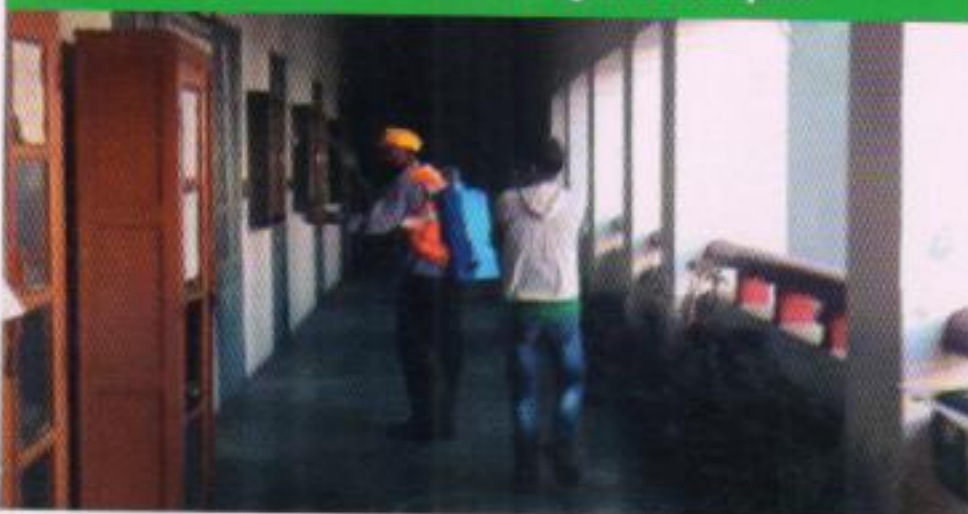
